Children in Wales Library

Children in Wales has a comprehensive information resource on children and young people housed at Children in Wales' offices in Cardiff and Caernarfon. We also send out regular mailings to our members to keep them up to date with the latest research and events in Wales.

The library holds:

- Collections of National Assembly and government documents and reports
- General books and research covering: education, special needs, health, children in care, poverty, child abuse, family, early years and many others
- A comprehensive collection of journals on children's issues
- Statistical digests
- A database of information on children's voluntary organisations in Wales, the UK and Europe
- A collection of press cuttings on current affairs relating to children
- Information about organisations and individuals with specialist knowledge
- Early news on events -conferences, seminars and workshops



The library is open from 10 am to 3 pm Monday to Thursday. There is a telephone service to answer enquiries and visits to the library can be made by appointment. Library visits are restricted to members of Children in Wales, but a library membership of £10 per year is available on request.

Children in Wales' Website

The Children in Wales website has information about services in each local authority area as well as job vacancies, information for parents and information about all areas of Children in Wales' work. The website also has a specific section dedicated to policy information relating to children and young people in Wales. It includes a guide to the policy making process in Wales as well as the latest news, documents, guidance and circulars, research, reports and consultations.

About the 4 Nations Child Policy Network



The 4 Nations Child Policy Network is a partnership between Children in Wales, the National Children's Bureau, Children in Northern Ireland, and Children in Scotland.

In 2001, the partners developed a policy information service for those working with children and young people. The purpose of the service was to bring together information from the four nations, to enable practitioners to understand comparative policy and identify best practice.

In September 2005, the 4 Nations Child Policy website was devolved to four linked websites run by each of the partners. From each site, users can find the national information that they need, as well as access comparable information from the other jurisdictions through links between the sites. Cross-nation news and the UK email bulletin provide up to date child policy information from across the UK political system.

Children in Wales Policy E-briefing

The Children in Wales Policy E-briefing is a monthly update on a range of policy issues affecting children in Wales. It provides information about the latest news, consultations and policy documents impacting on children and young people in Wales. Details are given about legislation passing through Westminster and proceedings taking place in the National Assembly for Wales. There is also a link to information about forthcoming events and current vacancies within the field.

The Policy E-briefing is provided **FREE OF CHARGE TO MEMBERS** of Children in Wales. Non-members can subscribe for an annual charge of £40.

Yn 2001, fe wnaeth y partneriaid ddatblygu gwasanaeth gwybodaeth polisi ar gyfer y sawl sy'n gweithio gyda phlant a phobl ifanc a diben y gwasanaeth oedd dod â gwybodaeth ynghyd oddi wrth y pedair cenedl mewn, i alluogi ymarferwyr ddeall polisi cymharol a nodi arferion gorau.

O fis Medi 2005, fe gafodd gwefan Polisi Plant y 4 Cenedl ei datganoli i bedair gwefan gysylltiedig a weithredir gan bob un o'r partneriaid.
